Robin Butler called the meeting to order at 8:30 a. m. The minutes from our February 26, 2008 meeting were approved as submitted.

OLD BUSINESS:

Philip Miller and Michael Blinn discussed the results of the Roadway Safety Assessment Team review of Greenwood / Lake Emma; Greenwood / Lake Mary; US 17-92 / Weldon; SR 46 / Sanford Ave.; Lockwood / Pauline and CR 419 / Snowhill. The committee made various recommendations including, but not limited to requests for striping modifications, tree trimming and the prohibition of right turns on red at one location. It was determined that a logging system of projects and reviews would be implemented prior to the next meeting.

Sgt. Pete Brenenstuhl discussed the Spring Break Enforcement wave which will be conducted on March 28 along the East Lake Mary extension toward SR 415. The

Briefing will be held at the Dist 2 S/O located on US 17/92 at Lake Mary Blvd beginning at 10:00 AM. Lt. Kelting will issue the press release for this event.

Sgt. Will Maxwell, WSPD asked about the maintenance of the existing RLCL's. Barry Wall advised that the shipment of LED bulbs for replacement should be in anytime and SCTE will begin swapping out the bulbs upon receipt. As far as the damaged parts, PELCO, the manufacturer has made modifications to the design, but they will not replace any of the existing parts.

NEW BUSINESS:

Geneveva Fruet, City of Oviedo, brought forth a Safe Routes to School Grant application for pedestrian railings on CR 419 around the lake near Jackson Heights Elementary School and the construction of approximately .73 miles of sidewalk to fill in gaps in the vicinity of Lawton Elementary. The CTST voted unanimously to support this Grant application. Data for this Grant was obtained from the School Zone Safety review conducted by the City of Oviedo.

ASPD will coordinate and host the annual Cinco De' Mayo safety checkpoint on May 5, 2008. Lt. Hancock will provide additional details at the April meeting.

CPD will host the annual Memorial Day Wolf Pack Operation. The operation will be held sometime within May 23-26. Additional details will be available at future CTST meetings.

PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS:

All problems and solutions were reviewed and a request for response will be submitted to SCTE reference several signal questions (see attached).

FATALITIES TO DATE:

To date there have been 8 traffic fatalities in Seminole County since January 1, 2008. A brief review was provided.
