Larry Dobbins with FL Safety Council presented a brochure for our approval for the Child Restraint Offenders Program (C.R.O.P.) which will now be conducted at the FSC location on Primrose in Orlando. The new brochure is printed in English and on the opposite side, in Spanish. This will be available to all of the municipalities to be given to persons who receive a citation for not having a child properly restrained in their vehicle.
