Robin Butler called the meeting to order at 8:30 a. m. The minutes from the September 23, 2008 meeting were approved with modifications to the date of attendance from October 28 to September 23, 2008.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Labor Day Wolf-pack Operation hosted by Sanford PD resulted in 95 citations of which 6 were DUI as reported by Sgt. Ray Irvin, SPD.

All participating Agencies have not completed their on-line Enforcement Activity reporting form for the School Zone Safety Awareness operation conducted in October therefore the results of this activity are not available.

Colleen Jarrell reported on the findings of the Roadway Safety Assessment review reference **SR 434 at Mitchell Hammock**. The review has not been completed, but recommendations are the installation of signal head back plates, installation of LED lights in the signal head, consideration of a westbound right turn lane and review of the existing signal timings. Formal recommendations for this location are forthcoming.

Red Bug Lake Rd. at Tuscawilla review suggestions are possible addition of pavement yield markings from the southbound Tuscawilla right turn lane into the merge lane on Red Bug Lake Road, review of the existing radius and review of the existing signal phases. Formal recommendations are forthcoming.

3 traffic fatalities presented, and after review it was determined that each fatality was the direct result of driver/operator error.

Dom Carbonaro, ASPD discussed the annual Intersection Safety Awareness operation in Altamonte Springs currently scheduled for December 19. He will have an Ops plan available at the November CTST meeting.

Bob Cortes, Cortes Towing discussed the new OSHA requirements for reflective vests in effect Monday, November 24. Speeds of 20 MPH up to 50 require Type II vests and speeds greater than 50 MPH require a Type III vest.

Chris Dye, LMPD discussed that an analysis be conducted to determine if a crossing guard at Country Club was warranted. Per Mike Blinn, a review is currently underway and the results should be available by the November meeting.

Tom Banks, FDOT/LEL discussed the new interactive web site www.takethewheel.net "Drowsy Driving Awareness program materials and the upcoming L.A.N.C.E. mtg at 10 AM on 1/14 at OCSO. He also discussed pending changes to the Law Enforcement Challenge program and application.
