## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS**

Chess Club (60 minute program for kids ages 5+) — Play chess with other kids! Practice your strategy and moves. Learn from each other and from teen volunteers. There will be no formal instruction.

**Hero Street Invasion** (*Free. For families with children*) – Join us Saturday, October 5th from 11:00 AM - 3:00 PM for hero-themed stories, literacy activities and crafts. We'll also have photo ops with your favorite costumed superheroes and community helpers!

**Lego Club** (60 minute program for kids ages 5+) — Calling all Lego builders! Build your own Lego creation or collaborate with new friends. Legos are provided.

**Library Explorers** (30 - 45 minute program for ages 5+) — Explore science, art, and stories. Especially designed for school-age children to imagine, create, discover, and experiment.
