PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

- **Mother Goose on the Loose (20 minute program for children birth to 18 months with adult)** – Join us for the nationally recognized Mother Goose on the Loose early literacy program. Enjoy interacting with your wee one as you hear stories, learn nursery rhymes and finger-plays, sing, and move with scarves, and shake bells.
- **Art Starts (45 minute program for ages 0-4 with adult)** – For the littlest artists! Featuring free play with materials after a short early literacy skills based storytime.
- **Toddler Time (20 minute program for children 18 months to age 3 with adult)** – Stories, songs, puppets and finger-plays just for toddlers, while introducing early literacy concepts for parents and caregivers.
- **Preschool Storytime (20 minute program for children 3-5 years old with adult)** – Join in the fun with stories, songs, puppets and more that encourage development of early literacy skills.
- **Lullaby Storytime (30 minute program for families)** – Get ready for bed with stories, music, and activities incorporating early literacy skills. Geared toward ages 0-5, but the whole family is welcome.
- **Saturday Family Storytime (30 minute program for families)** – Practicing early literacy and pre-reading skills is fun with stories, songs, and fingerplays! This storytime is geared toward ages 0-5, but the whole family is welcome.
- **READING Paws (15 minute time slots for children reading independently)** – Children can sign up to practice reading aloud to a therapy dog. READING Paws helps young readers gain confidence and practice fluency! *Register at the Information Desk.*
- **Lego Club (1 hour program for ages 5+)** – Calling all Lego builders! Build your own Lego creation, or collaborate with new friends. Legos are provided.
- **Library Explorers (45 minute program for ages 5+)** – Explore science, art, and stories. Especially designed for school-age children to imagine, create, discover, and experiment!
- **Chess Club (1 hour program for ages 5+)** – Play chess with other kids! Practice your strategy and moves. Learn from each other and from teen volunteers. There will be no formal instruction.
- **Teen Book Talk (1 hour program for ages 13+)** – See the Teens Events Flyer for more information.
- **The Great Pumpkin Paint-Off (90 minute program for ages 13+)** – See the Teens Events Flyer for more information. *Registration required*
- **Zen Dogs for Teens (1 hour program for ages 13+)** – See the Teens Events Flyer for more information.
- **Fall Festival at Red Bug Lake Park (2-hour drop-in program geared toward ages 3-8 and families)** – Children’s librarians will lead special fall crafts and activities for kids throughout the park! Everyone is welcome to wear costumes.
- **Puppets in the Park at Greenwood Lakes Park (30-minute program geared toward ages 2-5 with caregivers)** – Bringing all the fun of library storytimes out to our Seminole County Parks! Children’s librarians will share stories, movement activities, and puppet shows.
