Slavia Road Widening Design

From Red Bug Lake Road to Aloma Avenue (S.R. 426)

Seminole County has postponed the public information meeting on Thursday, March 30, until Tuesday, April 18, at 6 p.m. The meeting will address plans to widen Slavia Road from Red Bug Lake Road to Aloma Avenue (S.R. 426). The public meeting is being held to update the community on the progress of design plans and answer questions.

The project proposes to widen Slavia Road to provide two travel lanes in each direction with a 10-foot-wide multi-use path on the north side of the road and a 5-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side. The design follows the preferred alternative approved by the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners in December 2020.

The meeting will be held in a hybrid format to allow interested persons the opportunity to attend in person or virtually over the internet. In both formats, attendees will have an opportunity to view a project presentation, speak with project team members, ask questions, and provide comments.
